Knowledge Exam

The Welding Knowledge exam is available through the SkillsUSA Champions Hub. Exams must be taken prior to Skilled Competitions.

Clothing Requirement

SkillsUSA official Khaki work Clothing is NOT required for this contest. Students will be required to wear attire that is acceptable for the industry as long as it DOES NOT identify them personally by name or by associated school. Penalty points will be deducted for violation.

Skilled Contest updates

We will potentially be using OAC, SMAW, GMAW, and GTAW. The machines that we will be using are the Miller Multimatic 255 and the Lincoln 300C's. These machines are both combination welding machines

SMAW- 1/8" 7018 and 1/8" 6010 electrodes

GMAW- .045 Hard Wire in Pulse Spray Transfer with C10 Shielding Gas

GTAW- 3/32"-1/8" Filler Rod

Contestants will lay out a plate and using oxy-acetylene equipment to cut several holes that are checked for accuracy and quality.

Students should bring Chipping Hammers, Wire Brush, MIG pliers/side cutters, combination square, soap stone or some sort of marking tool to make lines, 25' tape measure, welding hoods, PPE associated with welding/cutting, calculators if they so choose. Also bring some style of hammer in order to help them square up plates after taking if need be.

Contestants will participate in an orientation Prior to the start of the Welding Contest.
