# 2025 SkillsUSA ND Advisor of the Year Application Instructions

To nominate an instructor for the SkillsUSA ND Advisor of the Year, the nominee must meet the following:

## **Criteria/Eligibility:**

- Nominee must be a secondary or postsecondary educator involved in technical, skilled, and service occupations, including health occupations courses, and who have achieved prominence at the local, state or national levels.
- Nominee must be currently employed by a high school, postsecondary institution or area career & technical center.
- Nominee must be a paid SkillsUSA professional member.
- Nominees may not have received the SkillsUSA ND Advisor of the Year award for the past 3 years (2024, 2023, 2022).

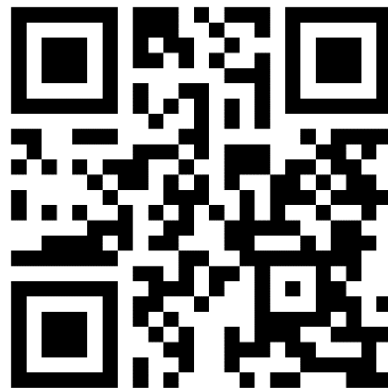
Review the following application questions and gather all your information. Once you have all your information, you will access the link below to submit your application.
